A motion was made by Swanson seconded by Walvatne and carried to approve the amended recycling contract with Engebretson Disposal as presented.

A review of CARES funding was discussed. A motion was made by Walvatne seconded by Swanson and carried to approve the request for CARES funds of \$22,675 from Horizon Public Health.

Consensus of the Commissioners was to set the county truth in taxation hearing date for Monday, December 21 at 6:00 p.m. in the Government Center first floor meeting room. There being no further business, the Chairman adjourned at 3:10 p.m.
